Please read and discuss Romans 1:21. What was it that made the search for joy so difficult for us?

There are many verses in the Scriptures concerning joy. Please read through some of these verses: Luke 6:22-23, Galatians 5:22-23, 1 Thessalonians 1:6, Romans 15:13, Philippians 1:25;4:5, 2 Corinthians 1:24, and James 1:2-4. As you do, what are some of the sources of joy that you see spoken of?
