STARTER

What had been your background or understanding of "end times" theology?

How does Jesus describe what the "days of the Son of Man" will be like?

Jesus makes the statement, "Whoever seeks to preserve his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life will keep it." In the context of the passage, what is Jesus communicating to the disciples?

MAKING IT REAL

How does it affect our living today as Christians that "the Kingdom of God is in the midst of you"?

When we consider the immanency of Jesus return, how does this shape our faith?

Jesus said that if we want to keep our lives, we must lose it. What does it look like to lose our lives for the sake of Jesus?
