THE MAN WHO IS GOD

Group Discussion Guide

In our time together in the book of Luke, we want to discover Jesus, the man who is God, in a fresh way. Each week we will be discovering a new aspect of who Jesus is and how we fulfilled God's redemptive plan for all creation.

STARTER

In the passage we read Sunday, we find that Jesus is asked a very politically and religiously charged question. Today we can find ourselves in similar conversations. What do you believe has made these conversations increasingly charged in our own culture? (This questions is not to discuss the issues that make us charged but to discuss underlying beliefs or practices have led to increased outrage.)

As we said Jesus faced a charged and difficult question, let's look at how he handled it and what we can learn from his answer.

GETTING INTO THE SCRIPTURE

Please take a few moments to read Luke 20:19-26.

First, with what attitude did Jesus respond to their question with?

Let's break down Jesus' response to their question by asking these three questions...

What is the significance of Jesus asking about the image on the coin?

What does it mean to give to Caesar what is Caesar's?

What does it mean to give to God the things that are God's?

MAKING IT REAL

Based on your answer above, what are the barrier to you giving to God what is God's?

What role does faith play in us giving to God what is God's?

DISCOVERING JESUS

Please take a few moments to pray a prayer of faith that we would live out our calling to give to the Lord what is His? In this you can pray that we would have the faith to do that and that the Lord would tear down the barriers to doing that.
