Reflect

Please take a moment and read Colossians 2:6-15.

Paul tells the Colossians in verse six to walk in Jesus as they received him. It is important for us to remember and live out of what Jesus has done for us. With this in mind, take a few moments to discuss this question, "What is the Gospel and what are it's implications in our lives?"

This passage makes two references to be dead or buried. Why would Paul include the fact that we have died to sin every time he mentions being made alive in Jesus? What is important about our understanding of our death to sin in our lives?

What are the blessings for those who are alive in Christ?

How can we actively remember our death to sin? How might this change how we live our lives?
