Looking back at how described what Gospel community looks like earlier, are there any differences between what you read in Colossians and what you said? If so, what are they?

What is the difference between a Gospel community and a community without the Gospel?

What personal ideas or thoughts must we be willing to set aside to pursue Gospel community?
