Who Is Like God?

Community Group Discussion Guide

In the Old Testament, the Lord spoke through his prophets. These were people of God that spoke the truths of God on his behalf. As this truth is revealed to the nations of Israel and Judah, they learn about the heart of God for justice and mercy. Through this revelation from the prophet Micah, the people have a choice as to how they will respond to the words of the Lord.

STARTER

As much as you can put yourselves in the shoes of a co-worker or friend who doesn't believe in Jesus. What would you say they believe God is like?

Our question this week is a massively important question. It pushes us to think about who God is and what he is like. As we look at the final words of Micah, he answers this question as way to remind the people of who God is and to give them hope for the future.

GETTING INTO THE SCRIPTURE

Please read Micah 7:18-20.

If you can grab a large piece of paper or something similar and write on it all of the things we see God doing in these verses. (There are at least 9 action words.)

Looking at all of these action and attributes together, what do these things communicate to us about the unique nature of God?

MAKING IT REAL

How is the uniqueness of God's character shape how we worship and live for Him?

When you think of your own personal view of God, what parts of your view of him do you believe need to be expanded or deepened? (Example: I know that God has forgiven me, but sometimes I doubt that God really sees me that way. God, please deepen my view of you as a God that pardons sin.)

PRAYER

Please take a few moments to pray and ask the Lord to deepen and expand your view of his greatness that your life may reflect the answer the question: Who is like God?
