November 5 – I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:6)

Main Idea: Jesus is God. There for he is the true path to life.

Heart Change: We would meet Jesus as our only hope and our access to God.

Open

What have been some of the defining moments in your relationship with God?

The disciples ask Jesus a interesting question, "How can we know the way?" Jesus replies with "I AM the Way, the Truth, and the Life." This response highlights a defining moment for the disciples as Jesus reveals more about who He is to them and ultimately to us.

Reflect

Please take a moment to read John 14:1-7.

Jesus says a lot in these few verses. What do we see Jesus promising to do in this passage?

How does Jesus explain the relationship between him and God the Father?

Apply

It is clear that the disciples do not understand everything that Jesus was trying to communicate at this time. How does their confusion either encourage you or discourage you in your relationship with Jesus?

What makes Jesus statement that he is the only way controversial to some people? How does this truth affect our viewpoint of the world?
