Group Discussion Guide

In our time together in the book of Luke, we want to discover Jesus, the man who is God, in a fresh way. Each week we will be discovering a new aspect of who Jesus is and how we fulfilled God's redemptive plan for all creation.

STARTER

At what point in your Christian faith did you realize that Jesus had called you to share the Gospel with others?

How have you attempted to do this in your life? How has it gone?

On Sunday, we talked about discovering Jesus as the Lord of the Harvest. As we talk more about this tonight we want to learn more about the mission Jesus has given to us and how we have empowered us for it.

GETTING INTO THE SCRIPTURE

Please take a few moments to read Luke 10:1-12.

What do you believe is the significance of Jesus sending them out two by two?

What does Jesus instruct them to talk about as they are going out?

What attitudes or characteristics does Jesus tell them to have as they go out to share the Gospel?

Why do you believe Jesus would say "the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few?"

MAKING IT REAL

What does it mean to worship Jesus as "Lord of the Harvest"? How does that aspect of his character shape how we follow and obey him?

If we have been called to love others and share the Gospel with them, what are the barriers in our life to effectively sharing the Gospel?

When it comes to sharing our faith, what does it look like to be faithful to Jesus?

DISCOVERING JESUS

In his book *Before Amen*, Max Lucado reports that more American Christians pray to win the lottery and for success in something they put no effort into (like a test or job) than they prayed for someone who didn't believe in Jesus. How can we refocus our hearts to pray and ask the Lord of the Harvest for a greater harvest?
