## *The King of Glory (Psalm 24)* *COMMUNITY GROUP DISCUSISON GUIDE*

In this psalm, David reminds us that God is sovereign over all things and is to be worshipped as the King of Glory. Because he is the King of Glory we are called to seek Him and worship Him with all of our being.

### CONVERSATION STARTER

As Christians, we are called to worship God as the King of Glory. What are some different ways that we can worship God?

### GETTING INTO THE SCRIPTURES

Please read aloud Psalm 24.

What are some things that stuck out to you from the sermon on Sunday and in reading this passage?

In Verse 1, David reminds us that the earth and everything in it belong to the Lord. As we think about what it means to be stewards of God's creation, how should we treat things that "belong" to us?

What does it look like to have "clean hands and a pure heart" and to "seek" God?

David says that, in order to "stand in His holy place," one must not "swear deceitfully". What does this mean?

### MAKING IT REAL

What do you need Jesus to help you overcome as you work toward having clean hands and a pure heart?

What will you do to seek Jesus this week?
