WHAT IS THE GOSPEL?

Jesus the King has Sent the Holy Spirit to His People Acts 1 & 2 Message Reflection Guide

When Paul articulates the gospel in Romans 1:4, he says that the Son has now been appointed Son-of-God-in-Power, but then qualifies the nature of Jesus' rule "according to the Spirit of Holiness." In other words, Jesus' reign is coextensive with the Spirit's empowering presence in the midst of his people. This is also why Paul can say that the Scripture preached the gospel in advance to Abraham. Likewise, Paul can state, "Our gospel came to you not only in word, but also in power and in the Holy Spirit and with full conviction." **The sending of the Holy Spirit is genuinely part of the gospel**.
